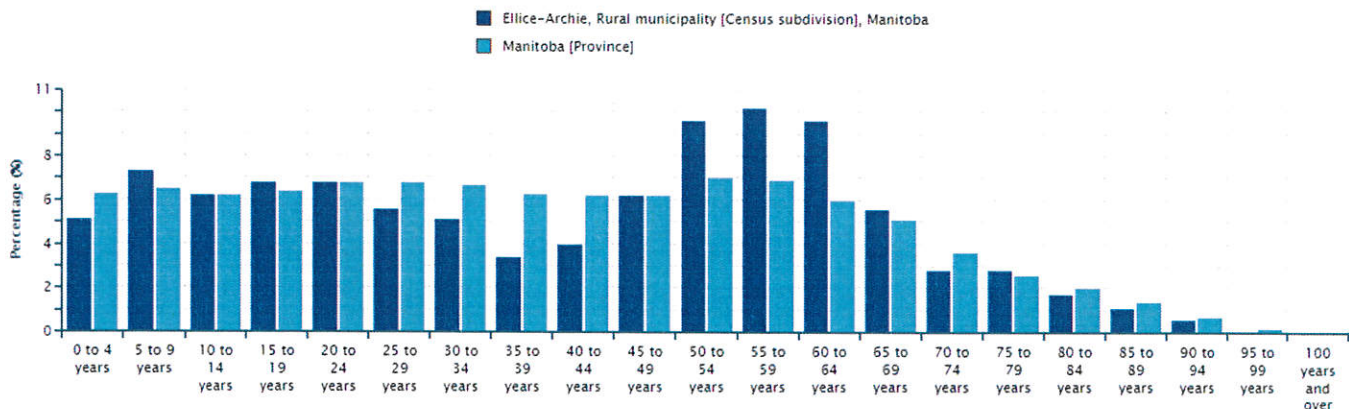

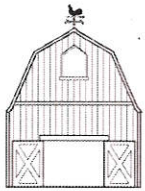

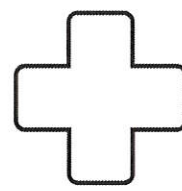

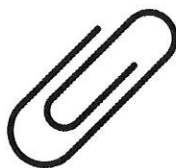

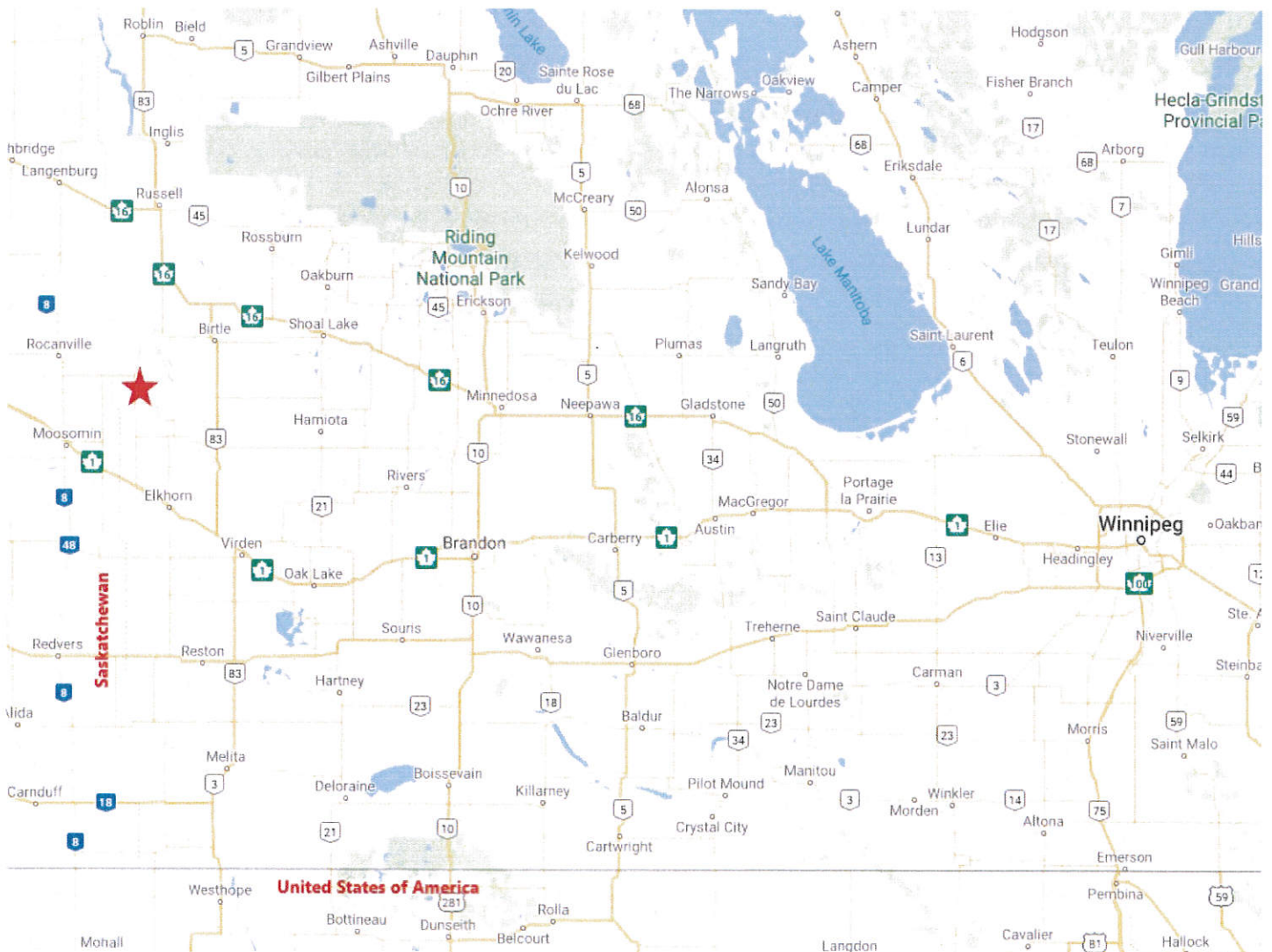
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1.1 Location

The municipality is accessible from main highways 41 and 42, and is located approximately 1.5 hours west of Brandon.

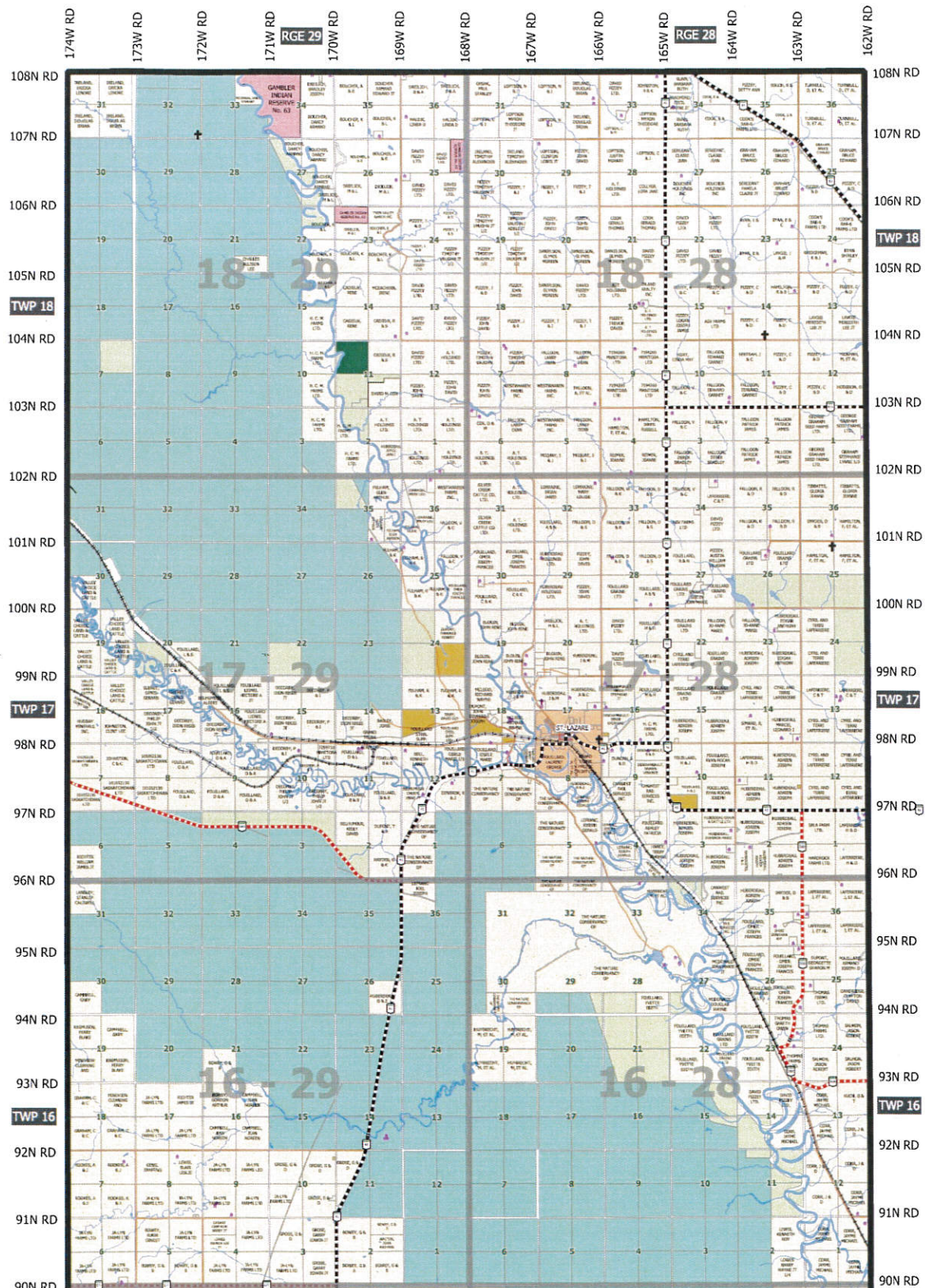
Figure 1: Ellice-Archie Location Map



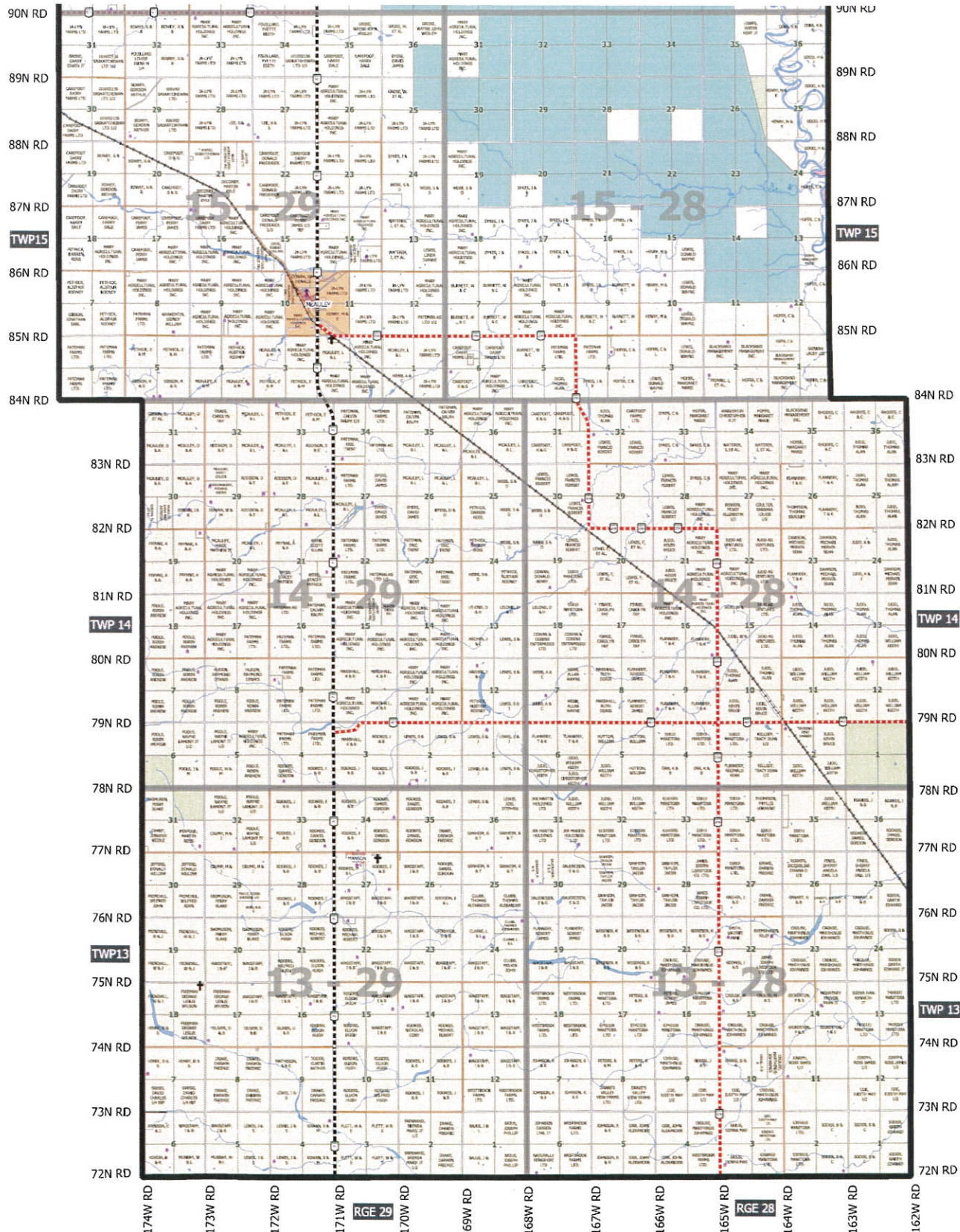

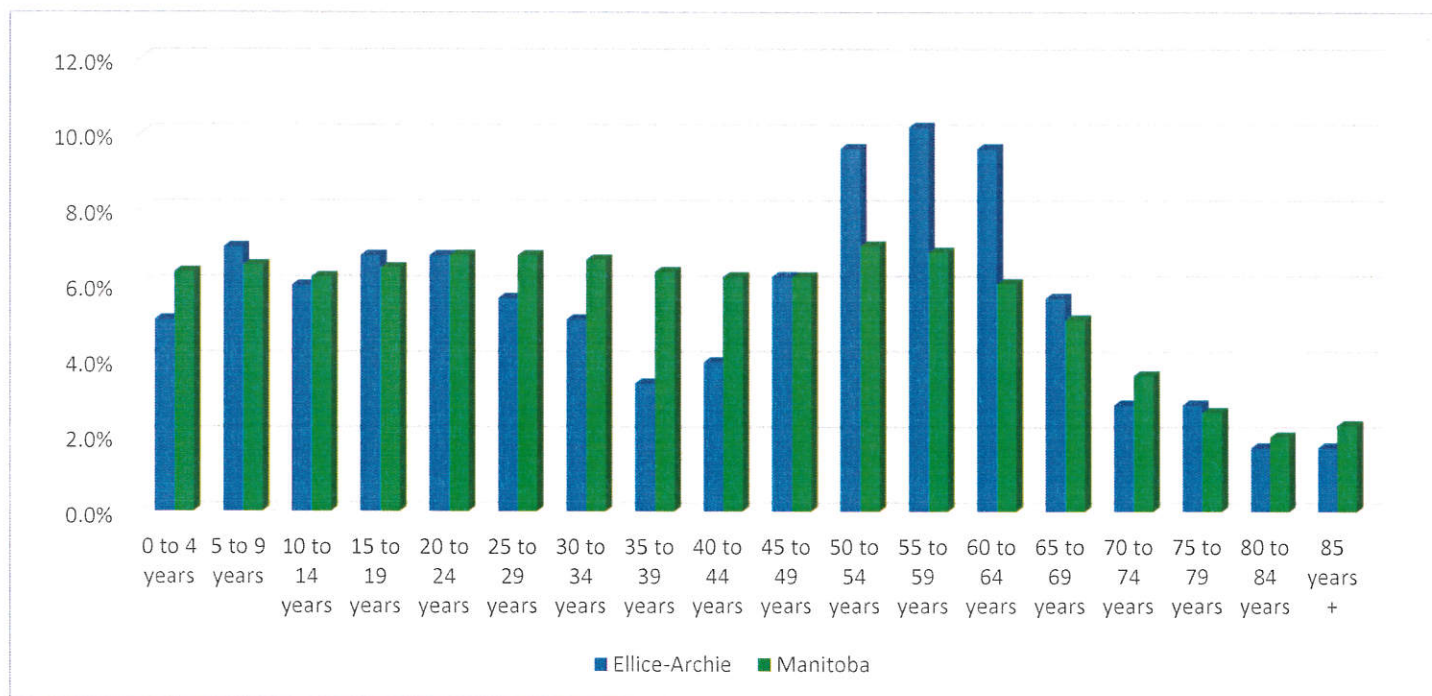

A person is classified as a non-mover if no difference exists. Otherwise, a person is classified as a mover and in this categorization is called Mobility status (1 year ago). Within the category of movers, a further distinction is made between non-migrants and migrants; this difference is called migration status.

² Non-movers are persons who, on Census Day, were living at the same address as the one at which they resided one year earlier.

³ Movers are persons who, on Census Day, were living at a different address from the one at which they resided one year earlier.

⁴ Non-migrants are movers who, on Census Day, were living at a different address, but in the same census subdivision (CSD) as the one they lived in one year earlier.

⁵ Migrants are movers who, on Census Day, were residing in a different CSD one year earlier (internal migrants) or who were living outside Canada one year earlier (external migrants).

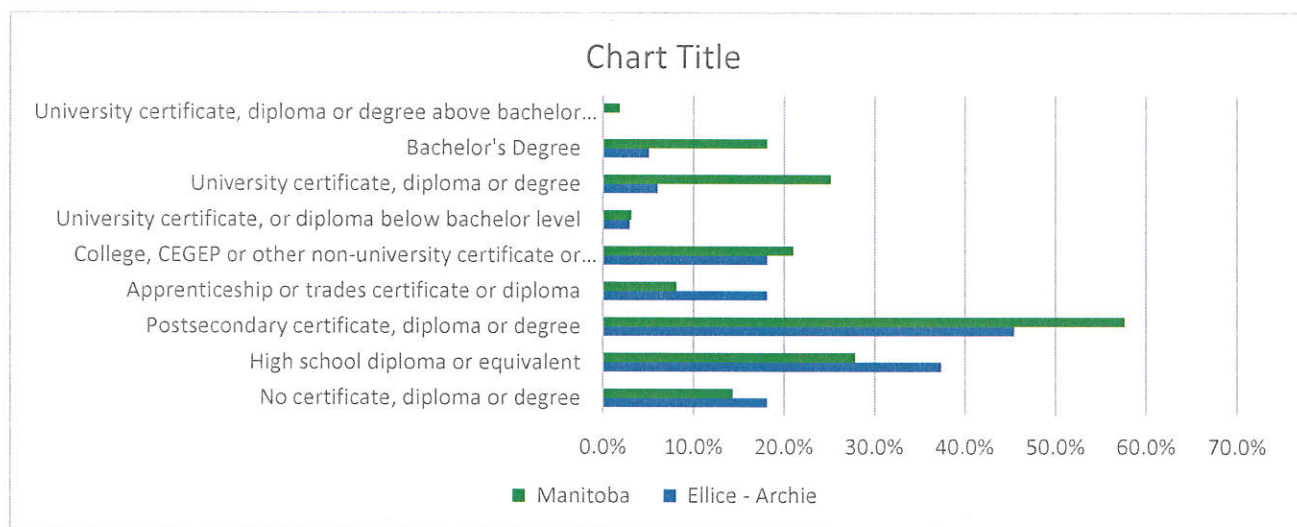
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2.5 Level of Education

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2.6 Income

3. Labour Force

3.1 Key Indicators

Ellice – Archie is home to a labour force that is over 700 persons strong. As illustrated in Table 11, the community participation rate and employment rate are higher than Manitoba. The unemployment rate is below that of the province.

Unemployment rate – refers to the unemployed expressed as a percentage of the labour force.

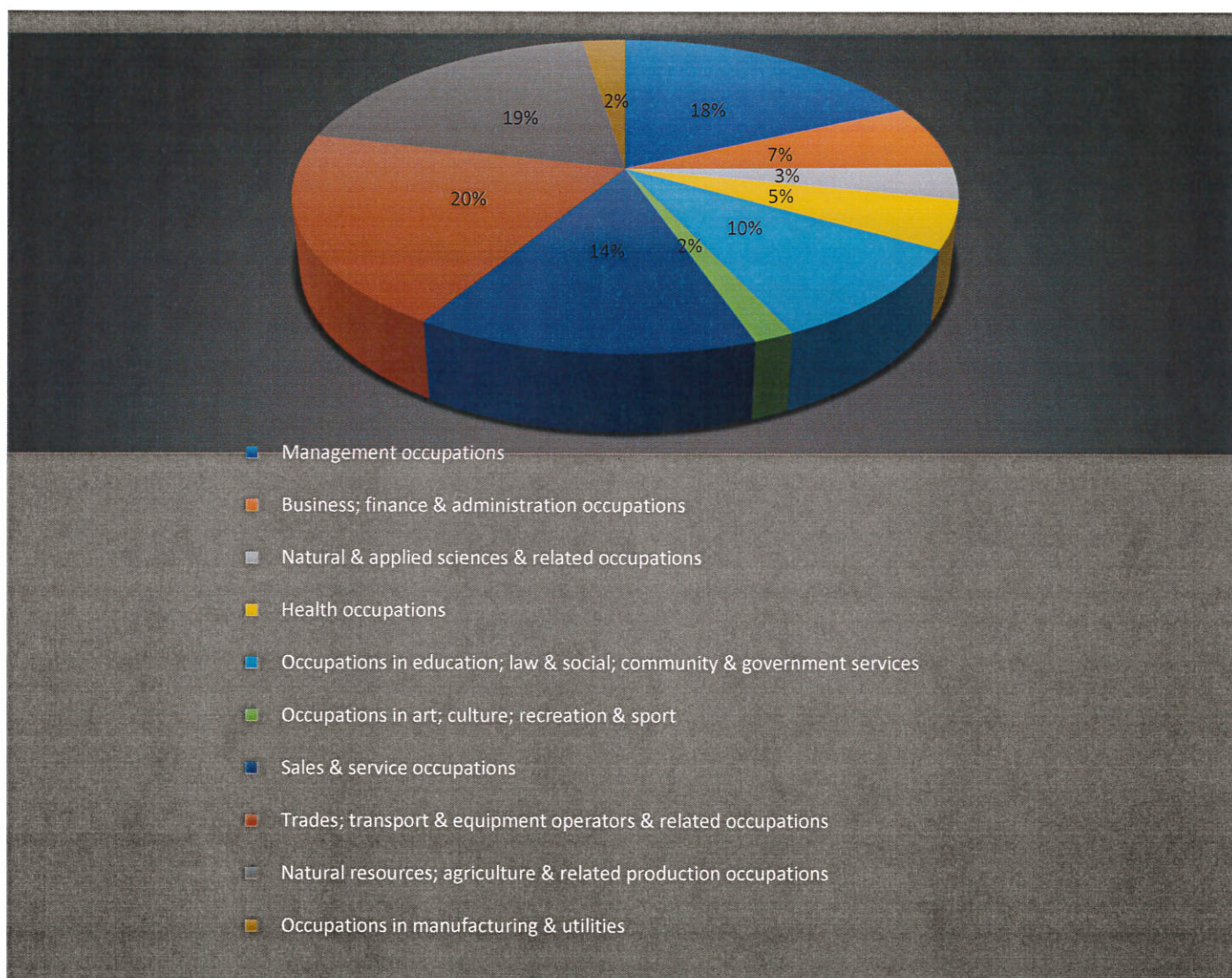
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3.2 Labour Force by Occupation

Figure 5 and Table 12 illustrate Pipestone labour force make up by occupation:

- The Trades, transport and equipment operators and related occupations represent the largest occupational group (20%) followed closely by the Natural resources; agriculture & related production occupations (19%) in the community
- The percentage of the labour force in Management occupations (18.5%) is also substantial.

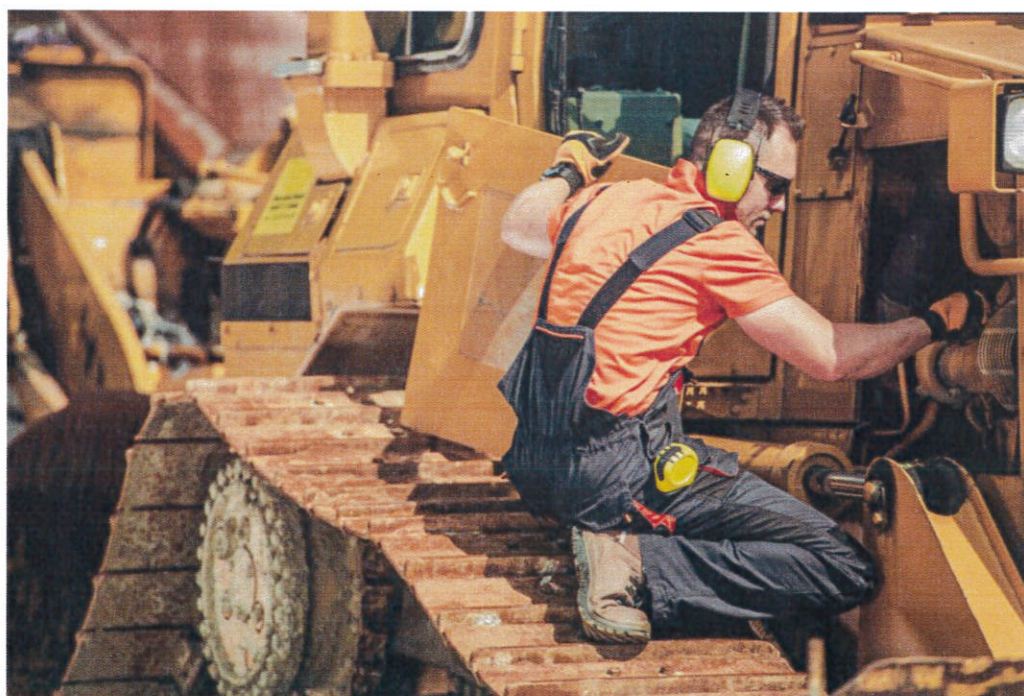

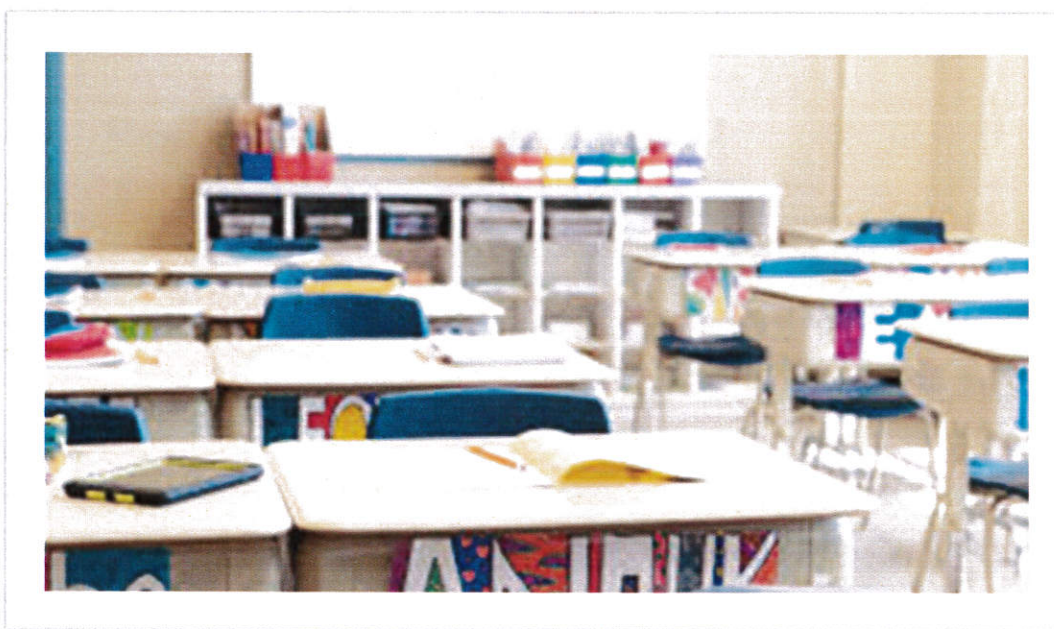

8.4 Recreation and Tourism

The wide-open prairie sky, prairie fields and Assiniboine valley contribute to the natural beauty of the RM of Ellice – Archie.

Take a cruise down memory lane by visiting over a dozen historic School Carins and War Memorials throughout the municipality. Or check out the Fort Ellice Site which was established in 1831 by the Hudson's Bay Company on Beaver Creek as a strategic point for northwest trade routes. Take a self-guided walk down the nature trails provided by Nature Conservancy of Canada, ideal for bird watching.

In the summer, park your camper or pitch your tent in one of the two campgrounds, or take the kids for a play in one of the several park / playgrounds. During the winter the municipality is home to three community rinks with natural ice open to public skating: Manson Community Rink, McAuley Memorial Rink and the St. Lazare Arena.
